


CHANIA, CRETE

Chania has a rich culture which echoes throughout the architecture of the town. A stay at the Aria Hotels will connect you with Chania's colourful history and draw you into all that the town has to offer.

Despite being heavily bombed during World War II, Chania's Old Town is considered the most beautiful urban district on Crete, especially the crumbling Venetian harbour. The borders of the Old Town are the mostly destroyed old Venetian wall and this has been the cradle of all the civilizations which were developed in the area. The central part of the old town is named Kasteli and has been inhabited since Neolithic times. It is located on a small hill right next to the seafront and has always been the ideal place for a settlement due to its secure



position, its location next to the harbour and its proximity to the fertile valley in the south. Nowadays it is a bit more quiet than the neighbouring areas of the west part of the district. The Splantzia quarter (next to the east part of Kasteli) is also largely untouched and very atmospheric.

The beautiful city of Chania has preserved its original colours and historical character, throughout time. It is considered one of the most beautiful cities in Greece and the most picturesque city of Crete. The Venetian, Turkish and modern architectures all combine harmoniously to create a unique attraction. The town also features archaeological sites, temples, and numerous cultural attractions.

ALCANEA SUITE

ASTRAIA & ASTRAKI RESIDENCE

Astraia and Astraki Residences, are situated where once stood the Venetian monastery of Santa Maria dei Miracoli, built by Marussa Mengano in 1615 for the Dominican nuns of Chania. Within walking distance from the entertainment attractions and the major monuments of the ancient city of Chania, they offer all modern comforts and facilities as well as magnificent views of the Old Port. The blend of the contemporary interior design with the touches from the past transports you into a different era.

Astraia Residence (114 sq.m) is a stylish two-storey vacation home, which features all modern comforts and amenities and offers a magnificent view over the Chania Old Port. Guest accommodation comprises two bedrooms, a spacious living room, a fully equipped open space kitchen, two bathrooms with shower and a rooftop terrace. FILEAS ART HOTEL

Fileas Art Hotel is located in the heart of Chania Town and reflects its cosmopolitan character through diverse works of art to create an extra special atmosphere. The hotel is housed in a three-storey building, connecting with a staircase, and comprises six spacious Double Rooms, offering all modern comforts and amenities. This intimate boutique hotel is ideal for couples who wish to experience the authentic Greek hospitality of Aria Hotels. Each room includes a double bed, desk, vanity desk, a flat screen TV and a bathroom with shower.

There are two Double Rooms on the ground/street level (Deluxe Double and Superior Double, 25 sq.m. and 35 sq.m, respectively), each with its own private entrance at the façade of the building. The first and second level comprise four Superior Double Rooms in total of 35 sq.m. each.













VIII A ATHERMIGO

Villa Athermigo is an elegant boutique-style villa in the picturesque village of Gavalohori outside the historic town of Chania. A 250 year-old olive oil press has been recently restored to combine discreet rural chic with all the amenities that holidaymakers expect.

Villa Athermigo is an ancient monument, a remarkable example of local, traditional architecture. Elements such as the main entrance, the stone openings, the interior patio, the traditional exterior oven, the well and the semi-circular arches typical of the architecture of the time, as well as the original oil extraction machinery, have all been preserved intact.

The villa can be rented as a whole to accommodate parties of up to ten people or as individual self-contained Cottages each sleeping between two and four people. Guests in all three accommodation units share a luxurious lounge and kitchen as well as the courtyard and garden with its secluded private swimming pool. The three deluxe cottages are named after the trees on the property: Elia (Olive tree), Rodia (Pomegranate tree) and Karydia (Walnut tree).

Elia, a two-storey Cottage of 50 m², may accommodate up to four people. It has a double built-in bed, a walk-in closet, a writing desk with fireplace as well as a bathroom with shower on the ground floor. An internal staircase leads to the upper loft-style floor, which offers a second bedroom with two single beds. Karydia, a ground level cottage of 40 m², may accommodate up to two people. It has a king size bed, a writing desk and fireplace and a bathroom with shower. Its terrace, located at the exterior area of the cottage house, offers great views to the garden and the pool of the complex. Rodia, a two-storey Cottage of 80 m², is the most spacious and may accommodate up to four people. It has a king size bed and a bathroom, with both a tub and a shower on the ground floor. An internal staircase leads to the upper loft style floor, which offers a second bedroom with a king size bed, and a bathroom with shower.
