LOUKOUMIA

Loukoumia are soft, chewy candies made from sugar, water, and cornstarch. They are often flavored with rosewater, mastic, or lemon juice and dusted with powdered sugar. The candies are like Turkish Delight and are a popular dessert or snack in Greece.

To make Loukoumia, start by combining sugar and water in a saucepan and heating the mixture over medium heat. In a separate bowl, mix cornstarch with water until smooth. Once the sugar mixture comes to a boil, slowly add the cornstarch mixture, stirring constantly. Continue stirring until the mixture thickens and begins to pull away from the sides of the pan.

Next, add your desired flavoring (such as rosewater or lemon juice) and pour the mixture into a greased baking dish. Let the mixture cool to room temperature before cutting into squares and dusting with powdered sugar. Visitors to Syros can sample these delicious candies at local bakeries and sweet shops. Loukoumia make a perfect souvenir or gift to bring back home, or a sweet treat to enjoy while exploring the island's beautiful beaches and charming villages.


