In 2022, Aria Hotels signed a first-of-its-kind agreement with Libra Group's aviation subsidiary, LCI, to lease 10 electric vertical take-off and landing aircraft (eVTOLs), allowing guests to traverse the Greek isles in a sustainable, cost-efficient, safe way. In 2024, Aria Hotels announced that it will build and operate four vertiports to support the eVTOLs.

The Aria Hotels story began in 2009 with the acquisition of The Windmill in Kimolos Island, and the conversion of a traditional Greek windmill dating from 1852 into a boutique hotel.

Aria's collection is famous for the diversity of the properties and destinations, and couldn't be complete without an exclusive private island, Pegassus, close to Evia island that has been added to the portfolio, along with and ranges from suites in the heart of Athens to an exclusive mountain boutique hotel, suites, beach houses to popular destinations like Crete, Cyclades, Peloponnese, Sporades, Dodecanese, Athens, Evia and the Ionian Islands.


